Synopsis

Victim of Geography walks on the wired, weird and wild sides of Europe.

Based on a road-trip from the centre of a vortex (war-torn Sarajevo) to the edge of an abyss (Cape Wrath at Scotland's most northerly tip), *Victim of Geography* redefined the creative documentary form/road movie genre for a pre-millennium/techno-tuned in and turned on audience.

Visually rich and multi-textured, *Victim of Geography* is a documentary 'postcard from the edge' that shoots from the hip and crosses the political geography, time and territory of Europe, in the company of the
